O5/16 Proposal to change the fee structure for the Nationality Checking Service

A report of the Chief Executive was considered to note the implementation of an online option for customers wanting to book an appointment for the Nationality Checking Service. The report also sought authorisation for a proposed change to the fee structure for the Nationality Checking Service to £70 per adult and £50 per child.

The Director of Governance explained that the existing system has meant that the Council has historically effectively turned away 80% of the achievable income from this discretionary service and that the implementation of an online appointments booking service would enable customers to access the service at any time and help to increase the number of NCS appointments carried out by the Council, increasing the income generated by this service. The new and more simplified fee structure would be easier for customers to understand and would both bring fees in line with other Local Authorities and help to generate additional income of an estimated £43k in 2016-17.
