

Report of the Strategic Director of Communities and Place

Communities, Environment and Regulatory Services Fees and Charges 2016/17

SUMMARY

- 1.1 The Communities and Place Directorate annually reviews its fees and charges. This is to ensure that they reflect the cost of delivering services, take into account comparator rates for these services within the sector, ensure that inflationary cost increases are taken into account, and that budget income targets are achieved. The fees and charges were considered recently on 30 March but there was an error in the information provided for the Domestic Pest Control Service.
- 1.2 The proposed revised fees and charges for the Domestic Pest Control Service in Communities, Environment and Regulatory Services for 2016/17 are set out at Appendix 2.
- 1.3 All prices are shown inclusive of VAT where it is applicable, unless explicitly stated otherwise.

RECOMMENDATION

^{2.1} To approve the revised 2016/17 fees and charges for the Domestic Pest Control Service as set out at Appendix 2.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 4.1 As part of the 2016/17 budget preparation, Departments within the Communities and Place Directorate have reviewed their fees and charges. This annual review is necessary to ensure that:
 - Inflationary cost increases are incorporated into the charging structure where applicable;
 - Any additional costs (or efficiencies) of providing the service are incorporated;
 - Fees and charges reflect the cost of delivering the service and/or charging levels for that sector.
- 4.2 The proposed 2016/17 fees and charges for the Domestic Pest Control Service are set out at Appendix 2.
- 4.3 Although a non-statutory service, Members have been keen to see the continuation of the Council's pest control service for Derby residents and businesses as an alternative option to private companies. The service receives 2,200+ requests for service each year and there are currently 45+ commercial contracts in place. The service regularly receives complimentary feedback from residents.

There is a need for the service to remain competitive in the local market and yet still offer value for money and a trusted, flexible, high quality service delivered by fully trained, experienced competent staff.

The introduction of Universal Credit and the need to move away from accepting cash at the door has created some operational issues that have needed to be addressed. The removal of the benefit-related reduced rate and no longer accepting cash payments at time of treatment have already been agreed.

A number of changes to the service are proposed:

- Full price rate for all jobs booked over the phone via Derby Direct, with the introduction of a new reduced rate for all jobs booked (and subsequently paid for) on-line, via a new on-line booking tool (to be introduced Autumn 2016). Reduced price based on a 15% reduction on full price treatment charge
- Review of service terms and conditions around survey only, cancellations and 'no-access' jobs, with the introduction of an administrative charge where an active infestation cannot be found or treatment cannot legally be undertaken. A refund will be made minus the administrative charge, an administrative charge where an appointment is cancelled, with less than one working day's notice given.
