

Joined Up Care in the Community

SUMMARY

- 1.1 The South Derbyshire Clinical Commissioning Group (SDCCG) has been invited to inform the Board of proposals to deliver rehabilitation services in the city, supporting at home care rather than people having to stay in hospitals in order to convalesce.
