Report of the Strategic Director of Communities and Place

Communities, Environment and Regulatory Services Fees and Charges 2016/17

SUMMARY

- 1.1 The Communities, Environment and Regulatory Services Directorate annually reviews its fees and charges. This is to ensure that they reflect the cost of delivering services, take into account comparator rates for these services within the sector, ensure that inflationary cost increases are taken into account, and that budget income targets are achieved.
- 1.2 The proposed fees and charges for Communities, Environment and Regulatory Services for 2016/17 are set out at Appendix 2. In those cases where the Council has discretion to set the fees, these have been reviewed. The final column of the table in Appendix 2 sets out a narrative for any changes being proposed.
- 1.3 All prices are shown inclusive of VAT where it is applicable, unless explicitly stated otherwise.

RECOMMENDATION

2.1 To approve the fees and charges for 2016/17 as set out at Appendix 2.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

3.1 To enable the Communities, Environment and Regulatory Services Directorate to achieve its budgeted income targets for 2016/17.

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 4.1 As part of the 2016/17 budget preparation, Departments within the Communities and Place Directorate have reviewed their fees and charges. This annual review is necessary to ensure that:
 - Inflationary cost increases are incorporated into the charging structure where applicable;
 - Any additional costs (or efficiencies) of providing the service are incorporated;
 - Fees and charges reflect the cost of delivering the service and/or charging levels for that sector.
- 4.2 The proposed fees and charges for 2016/17 for the Communities, Environment and Regulatory Services Department are set out at Appendix 2. Some of the fees are set nationally and cannot be changed by the Council. In those cases where the Council has discretion to set the fees, these have been reviewed. Where relevant, inflation has also been added. The final column of the table in Appendix 2 sets out a narrative for any changes being proposed.
- 4.3 The fees and charges relating to licensing functions are not included in Appendix 2, as these are considered separately by the Council's Licensing Committee.

4.4 Bereavement Services

Although the fees and charges for both funerals (burial and cremation) and memorialisation were not increased for 2015/16, increases are proposed for the 2016/17 period.

In addition, it is proposed to make some structural changes to the way cremations are charged. The strategy of using a differential approach to charging related to the time that the funeral takes place is becoming a commonly used approach by both public and private sector crematorium operators. It allows for reduced charges for the less popular early morning bookings up to 10.00 a.m. and late afternoon bookings from 14.00 p.m. onwards with premium charges for funerals between 11.20 and 14.00 hours. This approach has the advantages of balancing out funeral services throughout the day, which is far a far more environmentally sustainable and economic way of working and goes some way to addressing to emerging issues of funeral poverty that is gaining traction across the sector. Funeral Directors have been consulted on this proposal and have generally been in agreement.

In addition, it is proposed to increase the charge for scattering cremated remains that have been cremated elsewhere. This is proposed to take account of the numbers of families to the north of Derby who are having the main funeral service at neighbouring crematoria, in particular Amber Valley Crematorium at Swanwick, and then returning the cremated remains to Derby to be scattered with other family members in the Gardens of Remembrance at Markeaton. This situation will be further compounded when the planned Trent Valley Crematorium opens to the south of the city in 2017. It is hoped that this proposal will encourage those families with a choice about which crematorium to use, will be encouraged to opt for Markeaton Crematorium, rather to travel to competitor private sector facilities to the north and south of the city.

4.5 Markets

This service is currently under review which will include any fees and charges associated with it. Until the review is complete, the fees and charges will continue to be as approved at 24 February 2015 Cabinet Member meeting.

4.6 **Pest Control**

Although a non-statutory service, Members have been keen to see the continuation of the Council's pest control service for Derby residents and businesses as an alternative option to private companies. The service receives 2,200+ requests for service each year and there are currently 45+ commercial contracts in place. The service regularly receives complimentary feedback from residents.

There is a need for the service to remain competitive in the local market and yet still offer value for money and a trusted, flexible, high quality service delivered by fully trained, experienced competent staff.

The introduction of Universal Credit and the need to move away from accepting cash at the door has created some operational issues that have needed to be addressed. Consequently, a number of changes to the service have been proposed:

- No longer accept cash at time of treatment. All jobs booked either through Derby Direct or via a new on-line booking tool (to be introduced Summer 2016)
- Removal of benefit-related reduced rate
- Introduction of a new reduced rate for all jobs booked (and subsequently paid for) on-line
- Review of services offered to align better with those offered by other LA Pest Control Services
- Review of service terms and conditions around cancellations and 'no-access' jobs
